Shelley is also an extremely experienced public speaker and is passionate about sharing her thoughts and experiences in education, nature, conservation, photography, environmental entrepreneurship, leadership and professional development and environmental storytelling with audiences around the world.

Shelley is founder and president of BIOSPHERE Environmental Education. She is passionate about educating people, especially youth, about environmental and conservation issues and inspiring them to become stewards, protecting nature for themselves and for future generations. She uses photography and videography as tools to connect people to nature, along with exploring our own backyard and traveling to incredible places around the world.

Shelley has recently returned from a trip to Antarctica as a member of an international team of 75 women scientists on the Homeward Bound Women in Science Leadership Expedition.
