

OLA Groundwater sampling Program:

The purpose of this program is to provide OLA members with an analysis of the chemical quality of their well water. This determines the chemical potability of your drinking water and supports a purchase and sale agreement in the case that you want to sell your property in the future.

A Potability test includes an analysis of the concentration of the following chemical elements:

Alkalinity, Conductivity, pH, Fluoride, Chloride, Nitrite, Nitrate, Sulphate, Hardness, Calcium, Magnesium Sodium, Potassium, Iron, Manganese, Zinc, Copper.

Logistics:

Sample bottles are available at the AGM and by contacting Derek Smith (see below).

The cost of the analysis is \$100, tax included. This is a \$25 reduction from their normal analytical costs. The discount is for OLA members only. This is a good price for a professional analysis!
